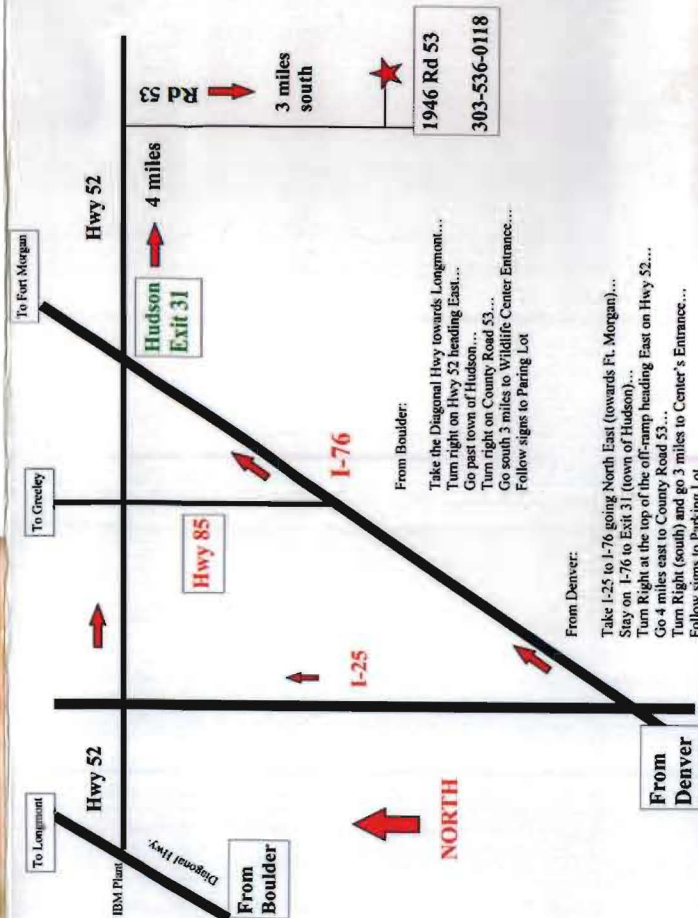

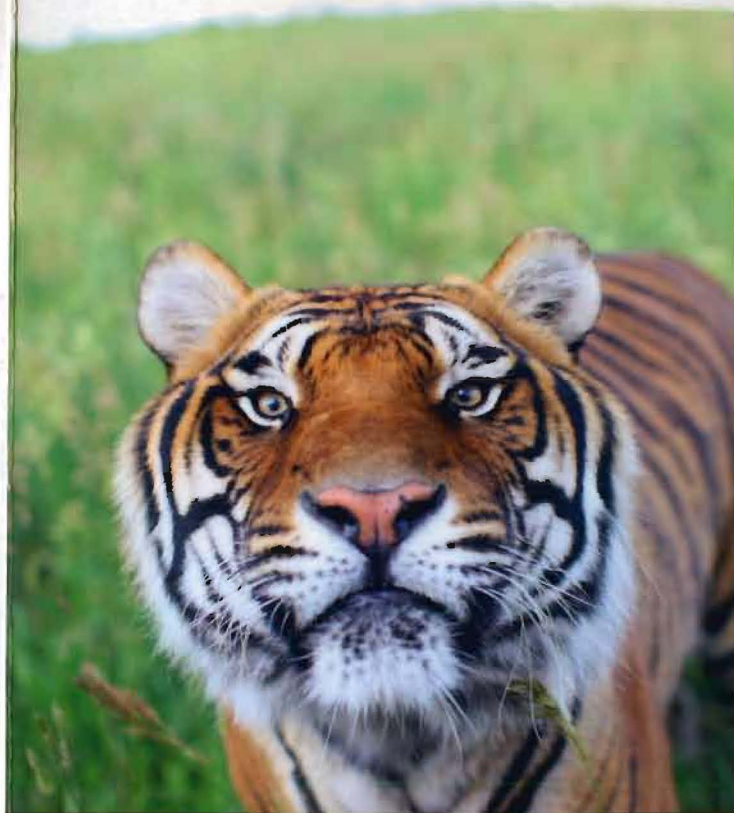

The Wild Animal Sanctuary is one of the largest and oldest Sanctuaries in the Country. It is also one of the only places where you can see Prides of African Lions and other Large Carnivores living freely in wide open spaces.



The Sanctuary is open daily, and offers educational tours to individuals, groups and schools. Experience our "Mile Into The Wild" walkway spanning one amazing habitat after another... and enjoy the spectacular view from inside our world famous Bolivian Lion House!



The vast majority of the animals residing at the Sanctuary were confiscated by law enforcement agencies after they were found being kept illegally in people's basements, apartments, garages, barns and other terrible places.
